Eligibility: As per UGC and Government of West Bengal norms.


Desirable Qualifications:

Job responsibilities:

- Engaging in other academic activities of the institution.


Remuneration: Payment will be on per class basis, not exceeding Rs. 10, 000/ month.



General instruction to candidates:

- i. Candidates must ensure before appearing in the walk-in interview that they are eligible according to the criteria stipulated in the advertisement. If the candidate is found ineligible at any stage of the recruitment process, he/she will be disqualified.
- ii. The number of vacant positions will be solely a matter of discretion of the selection committee.
- iii. The recruitment will be subject to renewal on satisfactory performance of the candidate.
- iv. The engagement is purely temporary, and candidates shall have no claim or entitlement to permanent employment in Pakuahat Degree College under any circumstance.
- v. No TA/DA or any other allowance will be admissible for attending the interview or the selection process.
- vi. The decision of the selection committee relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection will be considered final.
- vii. Reservation policy, if required, will be followed as per Govt. of West Bengal rules.
- viii. Candidates are requested to bring the original mark sheets and other relevant documents from class 10 onwards up to the highest degree, along with one set of self-attested photocopies, at the time of verification on the day of interview.

- x. Candidates reporting after 11:30am will not be permitted to attend the interview.
